

# TAG THAT trend WAVES

Prep the natural nail using a 180-grit file, remove dust & debris then apply Prep It! Ready to apply Flex It! Cover peach. Apply it in thin layers curing each one for 60-seconds in the Akzentz Hybrid Pro Lamp.

Apply a thin, even coat of HD Pro Matt It! Cure for 60-seconds in the Akzentz Hybrid Pro lamp.

Use the HD Pro Long liner brush and HD Pro art gel in color graphite to create a wavy line. The HD pro art gels cure to a tack-free finish, so are perfect for chrome nail art. Cure for 30-seconds in the Akzentz Hybrid pro lamp, then rub in the HD Compact chrome (silver shade) over the line. Remove any excess chrome with a soft dusting brush.

Use the same brush and the HD Pro art gel in mauve to create the next wave. Cure for 60-seconds in the Akzentz Hybrid Pro lamp.

Use the same brush and the HD Pro art gel in fuchsia pink to create the next waves. Cure for 60-seconds in the Akzentz Hybrid Pro lamp.



6

Use the same brush and the HD Pro art gel in colors, casper & sterling, to create the final waves. Cure for 60-seconds in the Akzentz Hybrid Pro lamp.



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Finish with either Shine It! Or Matt It, depending on the desired effect and cure for 60-seconds in the Akzentz Hybrid pro lamp.
