

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# MASTER class HAUTE COUTURE, HIGH FASHION NAIL DECO

### WHAT YOU NEED

Acrygel, embellishment adhesive, thick viscosity adhesive, peel off base coat, cuticle oil, rhinestones, LED/UV lamp, cuticle pusher, gel top coat, pink gel polish, glitter gel polish, e-file, extra long full well tips, lint-free wipes, 100-grit file, buffer, implements.

#### **GETTING PREPARED**

Set up your table ready to learn how to create interesting and diverse color compositions for crystal nail art designs. Make sure you work from an uncluttered working space. Place the nail tips and all other necessary products on a tray with your chosen colors on the table.

### NAIL PREPARATION



Take manicured nails & gently buff the surface with a 180-grit buffer. Then apply a thin layer of Peel Off Base Coat & allow it to air dry.



Choose your nail tip for each nail. Premeasured, full-well nail tips must fit from side to side & the cuticle area really snug & perfect. Line the nail extension up with the knuckle to ensure a straight line.

### **PRO TIPS**

• If you are creating nails for a photo shoot & want to remove the extensions after, use Peel Off Base Coat to easily remove the nails & save your nail art.



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Use acrygel to apply all fullwell preformed nail tips.



Look at each nail from the client's perspective to ensure it is perfectly straight. Flash cure after each one is placed.



Now apply the nails to all 5 fingers.





## **PRO TIPS**

• While filing or buffing a long extension, hold the tip of the nail with your thumb & use your other fingers under the extension to support the pressure of the buffer. This will give the nail stability & ensure client comfort.

## CREATE YOUR COUTURE DESIGN



Apply 1 coat of glitter UV/LED gel polish to 2 accent nails & cure.



Apply chosen color UV/LED gel polish color to remaining nails & cure.



Apply top coat to seal in the color before the deco stage begins.



Use a thick viscosity embellishment gel to set the larger stones & charms.



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### Place your large charm in the thick gel & flash cure to secure it.

### **PRO TIPS**

• When creating avant-garde & couture designs, always use an odd number of embellishments, while keeping the larger stones in the middle, as this creates a beautiful composition with a sleek look.



As you move down the nail, choose smaller charms & stones to gradually taper off the design to keep the feeling of long & sleek, chic nail styling.



Fill in all the gaps & crevices between the embellishments with embellishment adhesive & completely cure the design.

### **PRO TIPS**

Apply a thin viscosity
embellishment gel between
the charms to ensure the
design does not get caught
in hair or clothing. This gel will
give a really strong seal to
prevent any charms or stones
from coming loose.



Apply nail oil to the cuticle area & surrounding skin.

### **PRO TIPS**

• After curing product, wait 10-seconds before applying nail oil, this will ensure the product has cooled & does not absorb the oil & take away the shine.
