#### WHAT YOU NEED

Nail art brushes UV/LED top coat, glitter top coat, matte top coat, bullion beds. Crystals, alcohol inks, make-up sponge, gel paint, UV/LED lamp, 5 nail tips, gel adhesive

#### **GETTING PREPARED**

Prepare your table in an organized manner eliminating cross contamination from the products. Make sure all necessary products are within hand's reach, so the products are ready to use on the nail desk.

# LEVELING UP YOUR DESIGNS



Creating samples of your nail art will help manage time & proper pricing structure.



To add value & maximize time, use simple designs you are familiar with & incorporate embellishments & mixed media art.



Choose your favorite style of nail art, such as marbling.

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


With the marbling technique you will get a different result every time, so it's a great way to showcase a variety of designs quite quickly.



# MASTER *class* NEXT LEVEL NAIL ART BY GISELLE CABALLERO

# LEVEL 1 NAIL ART: OMBRÉ





Begin with a soft pink base on 5 full cover nail tips.



Sponge an ombré onto 2 of the nail tips. Cure the nail, then apply top coat & cure.



7 Now you have 2 accent nails with sponged ombré.

# LEVEL 2 NAIL ART: MARBLING WITH ALCOHOL INK



Apply art ink in a wavy design across the nail tip.

### **PRO TIPS**

• Abstract art can elevate your design & is less restrictive, as it leaves room for interpretation & requires less symmetry.



Use a brush & alcohol, then dilute one side of the design in this medium.



Add layers of alcohol ink to increase the intensity of the design.




Add glitter gel for more

dimension & increase the

complexity of the design.

PRO TIPS

• Nail art pricing should reflect the time, cost of product & skill required to complete it.



This is now a level 2 art set, with 2 full cover nails, 2 ombré nails & the marbled glitter accent nail. The cost of this set should reflect the addition of the accent nail.

# LEVEL 3 NAIL ART: ADDING EMBELLISHMENTS



Apply gel adhesive to the nail tip.



Apply crystals into the adhesive & when ready, cure.



Apply bullion/ caviar beads, coated in top coat, between the crystals to build up the design.



This is a level 3 set of nails, so price this set accordingly.

**PRO TIPS** 

Adding crystal or 3D embellishments is a quick & easy way to increase your value.

# LEVEL 4 NAIL ART: GLITTER TOP COAT



Apply glitter top coat gel & cure.



Apply preferred UV/LED top coat to each nail tip & cure.



This is level 4 nail art with different finishes in matte, glossy & glitter with embellishments, marbling & crystal techniques.

## **PRO TIPS**

• Using top coats with additives will change the final look of the nail & add an extra element of design.

• When using multiple top coats, use one type on all the chosen nails & cure. Then switch to the next style of top coat. This will save time.
